## Indigo Shibori Workshop

Sunday, July 31, 11 am- 2 pm

Learn the traditional Japanese dyeing technique Shibori with summer artist-in-residence Annie Tull. First, explore a variety of folding, tying, and stitching methods to create nature-inspired designs on cotton fabric. Then, learn how to make an indigo vat by mixing fruit sugars and indigo powder to dye the folded fabric. There is a \$30 materials fee due to the instructor. The fee covers all fabrics, dyes, and supplies. Class costs \$45, and members receive a 10% discount.

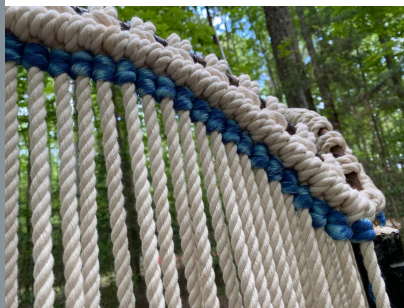


## Teen Workshop: Printing & Bookmaking

Friday, August 5, 10am- 12pm

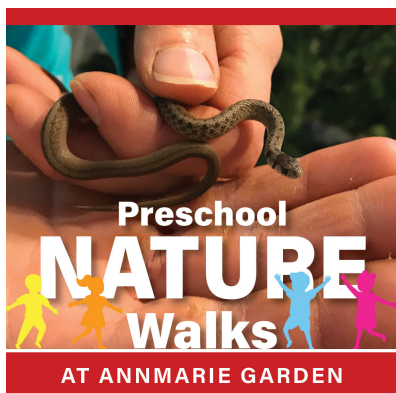
